Qualified from Aberdeen Medical School 1981, appointed as Consultant Anaesthetist in York (1989). Helped establish the first Acute Pain Service in the UK.

In 1991 he became responsible for the development of Day Surgery and has spent several years as Clinical Director for Anaesthesia, ICU and Theatres gaining extensive experience in the efficient running of both day and inpatient surgery.

Elected to the Council of the British Association of Day Surgery and served as Treasurer, Editor of the Journal and President. On joining the General Assembly of the International Association for Ambulatory Surgery he redeveloped the website ([www.iaas-med.com](http://www.iaas-med.com)) and helped establish the journal Ambulatory Surgery as a free access online resource ([www.ambulatorysurgery.org](http://www.ambulatorysurgery.org)).

He led the development of the online IAAS Training Manual while he was President of the IAAS from 2013-2015.

He has designed and overseen the development of multiple day surgery units in the UK – including a new 6 theatre day surgery unit in York and a Free standing day surgery unit 40 miles from his main hospital.
